A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FAMILY & CHILDREN'S SOCIETY, INC. TO SUPPORT A NEW BUILDING FOR OUTPATIENT MENTAL HEALTH AND ADDICTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with the Family & Children's Society, Inc., located at 257 Main St, Binghamton, New York, to support a new building to expand outpatient mental health and addiction services at the above address; and

WHEREAS, the amount is not to exceed \$200,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the Family & Children's Society, Inc., to support a new building to expand outpatient mental health and addiction services at 257 Main St., Binghamton, New York, at a cost not to exceed \$200,000; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line A4320.54000.F0015 (Contractual) for this purpose.
