

Small Business Interim Assistance Grant Program Frequently Asked Questions
eed a DUNS number in order to receive a grant?

A DUNS number is a required field for reporting CDBG program accomplishments in HUD's Integrated Disbursement Information System (IDIS) that is used to collect data for presentation to Congress. There is no charge to obtain a DUNS number and applications can be submitted online: https://www.dnb.com/duns-number/get-a-duns.html

How long can I receive assistance with this grant?

The grant will cover a period not to exceed three (3) consecutive months.

Will payments be made directly to the business owner?

Payments for mortgages, rents, and utilities (gas & electric) will be made directly to the entity that provides the service (e.g. mortgage holder, landlord, utility company).

I owed money for rent and utilities prior to March 22, 2020. Can these arrears be covered with this grant?

No. Grant funds can't be used to pay any amounts for rent, mortgage payments, or NYSEG bills that were owed prior to March 22, 2020.

Can the grant funds be used to refinance existing debt?

Is this grant taxable income for IRS & NYS income tax purposes?

Can grant funds be used to pay property taxes?

Yes. Pro-rated property taxes, along with water/sewer bills, will be an allowable use of grant funds.
