**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM NYS OPRHP FOR
A CITYWIDE SURVEY AND COMPILE A MPDF**

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton has been awarded \$25,625 from the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation (NYS OPRHP) to complete a citywide comprehensive survey of historic public education resources and compile a Multiple Property Documentation Form (MPDF); and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require a local match; the grant will be reimbursable; the grant funds will be administered by the Historic Preservation & Neighborhood Planner or his designee; and the estimated date of completion will be July 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept \$25,625 from the NYS OPRHP to complete a citywide comprehensive survey of historic public education resources and compile a MPDF; and the Comptroller is authorized to amend the budget accordingly.
