
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
CARES FOR THE USE OF CVY45 AND CDY47
FUNDING FOR THE BACKPACK AND SCHOOL
SUPPLY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Binghamton wishes to enter into an agreement with CARES for the use of CVY45 and CDY47 funding for the backpack and school supply program in an amount not to exceed \$13,160.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with CARES for the use of CVY45 and CDY47 funding for the backpack and school supply program, at a cost not to exceed \$13,160; and that funds shall be deducted from budget lines CD8760.535006.CVY45 (EDW-PROGRAM-NONPROFIT ASST) in the amount of \$10,920 and CD8676.533515.CDY47 (HUMAN SERVICES) in the amount of \$2,240 respectively and for this purpose.
