1. Project Address or Intersection: Court Street & State Street

Applicant: Hamza Kahn

Requested Review: Additional parking for delivery drop off spots

The Traffic Division, upon responding to that location and reviewing that area, found that accessible delivery and additional on street parking could be inserted on the east side of State Street by realigning the following zones. The Traffic Division therefore request that the Traffic Code Book be amended as follows:

<u>Delete:</u> Section 23. - No Parking Anytime Zone

State Street- East Side-from Court Street to 71' feet north.

State Street-East Side-From 251' north of Court Street to Commercial Alley.

Section 22.2. – Loading zones 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM weekdays and 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM on Saturdays (unless otherwise indicated).

State Street-East Side-from 71' north of Court Street to 93' north.

Section 44. – Kiosk Parking Meter Zones

State Street – East from 93' north of court Street to 228' north.

Section 22.3. – Parking for handicapped persons.

State Street – East from 228' north of Court Street to 251' north.

Insert: Section 23. – No Parking Anytime Zone

State Street – East Side – from Court Street to 10' north.

State Street - East side - from 252' north of Court Street to Commercial Alley.

Section 22.2. – Loading zones 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM weekdays and 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM on Saturdays (Unless otherwise indicated).

Section 44. – Kiosk Parking Meter Zones

State Street – east from 70' north of Court Street to 230' north.

Section 22.3. – Parking for handicapped persons.

State Street – East – from 230' north of Court Street to 252' north.

This above realignment will make the loading zone more accessible and create two additional Kiosk Parking spaces for the abutting business.

2. Project Address or Intersection: 5 Pine Street

Applicant: Kimberly Cuddy

Requested Review: Requesting a driveway curb cut between 3 & 5 Pine Street.

The Traffic Division, upon reviewing this request, observed that it was similar to other recent request for driveway cuts where either the property line is so close to the neighboring structure, or its own, that exiting or entering the property or vehicle causes the submitter to encroach on the neighboring property. This request is to insert a driveway cut in a limited space between 3 and 5 Pine Street and encroaching on the property of 3 Pine Street, adjacent to the driveway at 3 Pine Street. As shown in the IDC from a City of Binghamton map, that driveway cut appears to have been installed back in 2012, when the property was a restoration project.

Contact should be made by the submitter with the Engineers Office to see where the property line actually is. On the county tax map, it appears that there is not enough distance from the 5 Pine Street property line to insert a driveway without encroaching on the property of 3 Pine Street. It seems to be supported by the picture from the Binghamton maps of 2012 and 2019. Then Code Enforcement should be contacted to review whether the request meets city's warrants for inserting a shared driveway. Based on the above input, it would appear that the request does not meet those warrants, and Traffic Division would recommend that, unless the City Engineer's Office or the Planning Office find warrants to allow this action, move to deny this request.
