**ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CAPITAL  
AND GENERAL FUND BUDGET

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Ordinance 21-92, dated September 1, 2021, City Council approved amendments to the 2021 budget to use the fund balance to purchase equipment for (i) Police, to purchase pickup trucks, unmarked vehicles, crime scene vehicles, and SUV's in the amount of \$500,000, and (ii) Department of Public Works for purchase of garbage trucks, a freightliner M2, an international CV515, and a front end loader in the amount of \$800,000; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend Permanent Ordinance 21-92 to increase the budget line for purchase of garbage trucks by \$53,655; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on August 24, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Permanent Ordinance 21-92 is amended to (i) increase the budget line for purchase of garbage trucks by \$53,655, and (ii) as a result, the total budget amount is increased from \$1,300,000 to \$1,353,655 as follows:

- (i) \$53,655 decrease the Fund Balance
- (ii) \$53,655 increase expense budget line A9950.59000 (Transfer to Capital)
- (iii) \$53,655 increase revenue budget line H.45031 (Interfund Transfer)
- (iv) \$53,655 increase expense budget line H8160.55026 (Garbage Truck)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
