The oversized hedge on the NW corner (38 Lincoln Avenue) needs to be trimmed back to alleviate sight issues at that intersection. Forward to Code and DPW.

There have been 9 accidents at location; mostly right angle accidents from Chapin to Leroy, which indicates line of sight issue. The tree on the North East corner is obstructing the No Parking sign. Traffic Division recommends installing an over-sized stop sign, advanced warning signs and stop bars. Extending the no parking Here to Corner 30 ' cut to 50' cut on NE corner of Leroy Street (91 Chapin Street-on Leroy side). Also recommended by Traffic Division is to have the over grown hedge on the NE corner to be trimmed back to alleviate line of sight issues. Forward to Code and DPW. Intersection to be monitored for three months after improvements — revisit in November.
