AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2021 BUDGET TO USE FUND BALANCE TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT FOR POLICE AND DPW

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works, the Police Chief, and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2021 budget to use the fund balance to purchase equipment for Police and DPW; and

WHEREAS, Police will purchase pickup trucks, unmarked vehicles, crime scene vehicle, and SUV's at a cost not to exceed \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, DPW will purchase garbage trucks, a freightliner M2, an international CV515, and a front end loader at a cost not to exceed \$800,000; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on September 1, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2021 budget to use the fund balance to purchase equipment for Police and DPW, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,300,000 as follows:

- (i) \$1,300,000 decrease the Fund Balance
- (ii) \$1,300,000 increase expense budget line A9950.59000

(Transfer to Capital)

- (iii) \$1,300,000 increase revenue budget line H.45031
- (Interfund Transfer)
- (iv) \$ 500,000 increase expense budget line H3120.550026
- (Police Vehicle)
- (v) \$ 561,000 increase expense budget line H8160.55026
- (Garbage Truck)
- (vi) \$ 239,000 increase expense budget line H1490.510009

(DPW Equipment)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.

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

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton passed Permanent Resolution 20-48, dated June 17, 2020, authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Family Enrichment Network ("FEN") for use of CARES ACT COVID-19 relief funds for homeless prevention services; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton passed Permanent Resolution 20-53, dated June 17, 2020, authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the YWCA for use of CARES ACT COVID-19 relief funds for street outreach; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton passed Permanent Resolution 21-13, dated February 17, 2021, authorizing the Mayor to amend the FEN agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton passed Permanent Resolution 21-40, dated June 9, 2021, amending the YWCA agreement and budget to increase funding in the amount of \$61,418 for an outreach worker, including related travel and phone expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton passed Permanent Resolution 21-69, dated August 18, 2021, amending the existing agreements with the YWCA to extend the agreement to September 30, 2022; and

\$175,000 increase revenue budget line H.45031 (Interfund Trans.) (iii)

\$175,000 increase expense budget line H7110.550026 (Vehicles) (iv)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.


