## **ORDINANCE**

entitled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VARIOUS SECTIONS IN CHAPTER 5, ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to amend various sections of the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 5, *Administration of Government*.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 5, *Administration of Government*, §5-3, *City Hall Hours*, is amended as follows:

§ 5-3. City Hall hours. [Added 5-30-1973 by Ord. No. 106-73; Amended 12-21-2022 by Ord. No. 22-183] Except for certain designated holidays, —and certain special hours maintained by the City Treasurer's office for collection purposes, the new City Hall shall be opened throughout the entire year, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. In conformance with the negotiated Taylor Law contract between the City and the employees employed in the City Hall, the hours of said employees shall be from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with one hour for lunch, Monday through Friday, throughout the entire year.

Section 2. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 5, *Administration of Government*, §5-24, *Public Access to Records*, is amended as follows:

§ 5-24. Public access to records. [Added 4-21-1975 by Ord. No. 54-75; Amended 9-4-07 by Ord. No. 44-2007; Amended 5-19-08 by Ord. No. 27-2008; Amended 12-21-2022 by Ord. No. 22-183]

- (1) (1) The head of each department, bureau, or office listed below shall serve as records access officer for said department, bureau or office:
  - (a) Mayor.
  - (b) Assessment.
  - (c) Building Inspector. Construction & Code Inforcement
  - (d) City Clerk.
  - (e) City Court.
  - (f) (e) Civil Service & Personnel
  - (g) (f) Community Development & Planning
