AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2022
GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR
UNEMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2022 General Fund budget for unemployment costs in the amount of \$38,000; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on January 11, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2022 General Fund budget for unemployment costs in the amount of \$38,000 as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):

\$38,000 A9010.58000A (ERS Retirement)

Transfer To (Increase):

\$38,000 A9050.58000E (Unemp.Ins.)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
