


The purpose of this legislation is to address the City of Binghamton's Historic Design Guidelines restriction on internally lit signs, as follows:

“internally lit signs are generally inappropriate for historic buildings and districts.”

CAUD recommends approval of the following:

“While internally lit signs are generally inappropriate for historic buildings and districts, illumination by light shining through stencil cut letters (preferably with a dark background), in a style considered appropriate or fitting to the building, will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Internally lit, plastic faced, cabinet-type/box signs are not allowed. “

Case-by-case reviews would consider, among other defining characteristics of the building:

If the building had a previous land use where the intensity of lighting and need for wayfinding would be compatible with the function of the sign.

If the signage is on a low-density site and is not located in a typical historic urban streetscape, with a notable distance from the next building entrance reducing the risk of unrestricted proliferation of this type of lighting.

If alternate lighting techniques such as goose-neck lighting would be more invasive to the character of the building.

If the sign has some reference to traditional materials and imagery.

If the lighting is of a relatively low intensity compared to other similar signage.

Historic design guidelines from Peekskill and Saratoga Springs were reviewed regarding sign illumination, Peekskill allows light to shine through stencil cut letters on a case-by-case basis, and Saratoga Springs allows internal opaque halo-lit letters.

The proposed change was reviewed by SHPO with no identified issues.



