He grew up in Chenango Forks, is a SUNY Broome Alumni and holds a B.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from Binghamton University.



Laura Whitmore was the winner of the 2022 BLDC Business Plan Competition and is the owner of Strategic Test Prep, LLC a start-up company located at the Binghamton University Koffman Incubator that specializes in SAT and ACT test prep as well as math and science subject tutoring and college preparatory services. Its serves middle and high school students in the Southern Tier and offers in-person tutoring which is in demand as parents and students experienced limitations of remote learning during COVID. Laura also offers remote test prep services and has worked directly with students across the US, as well as in India, Finland, Azerbaijan, Nigeria, and Swaziland. Her growing YouTube channel, Strategic Test Prep, has over 5,000 subscribers in less than one year. Laura also created and launched Preptly, the first-to-market digital SAT prep mobile app, in March 2023.
