**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2022
GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR SALT AND
SAND**

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2022 General Fund budget for salt and sand in the amount of \$115; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on March 15, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2022 General Fund budget for salt and sand in the amount of \$115 as follows:

Transfer From (Decrease):

\$115 A5110.51900 (Overtime)

Transfer To (Increase):

\$115 A5142.54141 (Salt/Sand)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
