## **ORDINANCE**

entitled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2023 PARKS & RECREATION BUDGET TO DEFUND A MEO POSITION AND FUND A GROUNDSKEEPER POSITION

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Parks & Recreation and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2023 Parks & Recreation budget to defund a "MEO" position (\$22.60/hr) at an annual salary of \$47,008, and add a "Groundskeeper" position (\$23.75/hr) at an annual salary of \$49,400; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on April 11, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2023 Parks & Recreation budget to (i) defund a "MEO" position (\$22.60/hr) at an annual salary of \$47,008, (ii) add a "Groundskeeper" position (\$23.75/hr) at an annual salary of \$49,400; and (iii) fund the "Groundskeeper" position from April 15, 2023 to December 31, 2023 as follows:
