AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2023 FIRE BUDGET TO DEFUND 8 FIRST-GRADE FIREFIGHTER POSITIONS AND FUND 8 PROBATIONARY FIREFIGHTER POSITIONS

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2023 Fire budget to defund 8 "First-Grade Firefighter" positions and add 8 "Probationary Firefighter" positions; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on April 11, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:
