RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Atlantic Testing Laboratories for the special inspection agreement for the Water Street Parking Garage, in an amount not to exceed \$108,575; and that funds shall be deducted from budget line H5650.525080.22118 (Parking Ramps) for this purpose.
