**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ACCEPT A NYS OPRH EPF
RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM GRANT**

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible for the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation (NYS OPRH) Environmental Protection Fund (EPF) Recreational Trails Program Grant in the amount of \$500,000 to be used for creating publicly accessible trails and connections to existing pathways, restoring existing pathways, and restoring associated trail infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Grant requires a 20% match in the amount of \$100,000; the grant funds will be reimbursable, and the Grant will be administered by the Commissioner of Parks & Recreation or his designee; and the estimated date of completion will be December 15, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to accept the NYS OPRH EPF Recreational Trails Program Grant funds in the amount of \$500,000; and that funds will be available in budget line H7110.555555.PK020 for this purpose.
