A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A HOME RULE REQUEST TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON TO OFFER AN OPTIONAL TWENTY-FIVE YEAR RETIREMENT PLAN TO FIREFIGHTER SCOTT PAVLICK

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill A.5762 and Senate Bill S.5605 have been introduced into the New York State Assembly and Senate respectively, for the authority to allow for the enrollment of a firefighter who failed to make a timely application to participate in such optional twenty-five year retirement plan; and

WHEREAS, Scott Pavlick may elect to be covered by the provisions of section 384 of the retirement and social security law, and shall be entitled to the full rights and benefits associated with coverage under such section.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the City of Binghamton hereby urges and approves the adoption and passage of said Assembly Bill A.5762 and Senate Bill S.5605 entitled, "An Act to authorize the City of Binghamton to offer an optional twenty-five year retirement plan to firefighter Scott Pavlick" and hereby declares that a necessity exists for the passage of such bill and that the local Legislative Body of the City of Binghamton does not have the power to enact such Legislation by Local Law; and be it further

RESOLVED that a Home Rule Request be submitted to the Assembly and Senate of the New York State Legislature indicating the necessity exists for the enactment of said Legislation.
