**ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOCATE AMERICAN  
RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS FOR  
CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS OF THE  
TEAMSTERS CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to allocate American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in the amount of \$93,355.25 for retaining employees based on the Teamsters Contract; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on July 12, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to allocate ARPA funds in the amount of \$93,355.25 for retaining employees based on the Teamsters Contract as follows:


