

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES GRANT TO IMPLEMENT THE GIVE INITIATIVE AND FUND THE SOUTHERN TIER CRIME ANALYSIS CENTER

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is eligible to receive a grant in the amount of \$426,112 from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services (NYS DCJS); and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to implement the Gun Involved Violence Elimination (GIVE) initiative in efforts to stop violent crime, targeting firearm related crime, and aggravated assaults; and

WHEREAS, the grant will also fund aspects of the Southern Tier Crime Analysis Center (STCAC) including (i) the full salary and fringe benefits for a Civilian Crime Analyst and BPD FIO investigator, and (ii) the training expenses and overtime for crime reduction; and

WHEREAS, there is no required City match; that pending reimbursement, funding for the project shall be drawn from the general fund; that the head of Crime Prevention in the Binghamton Police Department will be the grant project manager; and that the anticipated date of project completion is June 30, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to accept a grant in the amount of \$426,112 from NYS DCJS to implement the GIVE initiative and fund the STCAC; and that funds will be available for this purpose.
