RESOLUTION 23-8 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON WATER STREET DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO ACCEPT A GAURANTEED MAXIMUM PRICE OF \$22,110,245 FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PARKING GARAGE AND \$3,050,300 FOR THE SIXTH FLOOOR PODIUM BY UNITED - PIKE DEVELOPMENT JV, LLC

C. Shager explained that there was an increase of \$50,000 to the contract based on delays. C. Shager gave an explanation of the sixth floor podium necessary to support housing on top of the parking structure. Parking options are planned for short term and long term parkers. R.
